

## Download/Upload

### **Definition: Download/Downloading:**

Downloading is when you are receiving data in the form of a file/video/mp3 etc from a remote source. There are MANY types of data that can be downloaded from the Internet. Such as:

MP3 (audio tracks)  
MP4 (video files)  
AVI (movie/video file format)  
ZIP Archives (compressed files)  
RAR Archives (compressed files)  
Bittorrent files (normally for downloading TV Shows etc)  
PDF (manuals/guides/handouts etc)  
JPG (image file)  
BMP (image file)  
EXE (setup files for software)  
Etc.....

To download files from the Internet is actually very easy. There is always a download button of some sort, see below:



You would just click on this, save the EXE etc... file to a suitable location, i.e. Desktop. Minimise/close all other windows so that you can see the Desktop. You will have a new icon (small pic). Double click on this to start installation. Then you just follow the installation prompts. Say 'I agree' to any terms etc. Say 'No' to installing Toolbars. Finish installation, then you can delete setup file by: right click on setup icon and select Delete. Say 'Yes' to move to Recycle Bin. Go to Recycle Bin icon. Right click and select 'Empty Recycle Bin'. Select 'Yes' to confirm deletion.

### **Re: Dial Up/Broadband Speeds**

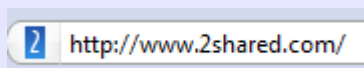
Download speeds are generally faster than Upload speeds. Meaning that uploading a file(s) will normally take quite a while longer than Downloading. But it does also depend on the size of the file. If a file is only a few KB then it won't take long at all. If the file(s) are in the MB or even GB they will take some time.

### **Definition: Upload/Uploading:**

Upload or Uploading is just the opposite of Download and Downloading. With uploads you are sending a copy of a file to a remote source.

### **A good way to practice Downloading & Uploading:**

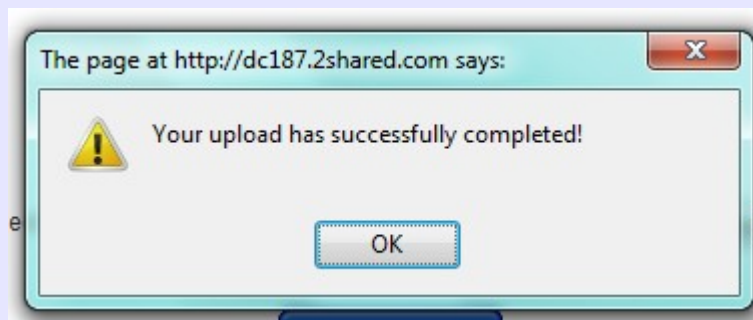
Visit:



Click on BROWSE and select a file of ANY type. Click on Open to select file. Then click on UPLOAD IT!.

Select a file:

Click OK.

You will then have the following, for your file:
